WHEREAS, the City owns certain property within the City's corporate limits located south of Washington Street and east of Fourteenth Street, which is commonly known as Byerly Park, whereupon the City maintains the facilities, including buildings, improvements, and parking area thereon, for use by patrons and spectators who participate in and watch various sporting activities; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Parks & Leisure Services Department has numerous team and tournament sporting events taking place at various locations within Byerly Park, none of which fully occupy the said facilities at all times during the calendar year; and,

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of entering into Recreational Use Agreements whereby Byerly Park can be utilized for certain athletic programs to use for practice and for sporting contests; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City Manager is hereby given the authority to approve recreational use agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents for recreational use agreements.
