The following matters were discussed:

Committee members presented updates on fundraising techniques. Heusel is responsible for drafting a letter to send to families of those who are buried in the cemetery to facilitate fundraising efforts. Staff provided updates on current fundraising efforts; no change since the August meeting.

Committee members brainstormed ideas for fundraising receipt methods. A Facebook page with links to the city's website was discussed, along with a payment portal for donations on hartsvillesc.gov.

Committee members discussed a name change for the cemetery. It was decided that all names associated with the cemetery will need to be documented for future use on the National Registry.

Andrews provided an overview of the Preservation Workshop.

Staff provided updates on current marketing efforts. A sign will be put on site on Friday, September 23, 2016. Staff will provide the press with photos from the Preservation Workshop.

The next Council African-American Cemetery Meeting was scheduled for October 27, 2016 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers.
