

**RESOLUTION 12-16-01**

**AUTHORIZING THE WAIVING OF BUSINESS LICENSE FEES FOR THE MONTHLY HARTSVILLE FARMERS MARKET AND THE WEEKLY CENTENNIAL MARKET EVENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Hartsville Farmer's Market will offer local and area products of various vendors, including farm produce, meats and cheeses, baked goods, personally produced arts, crafts and various other products approved by Main Street Hartsville's Juried Committee, and the downtown store owners have requested that we integrate this event with their retail sales to make a bigger event along the 100 block of East Carolina Avenue; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hartsville intends to continue to co-sponsor with Main Street Hartsville a Centennial Market, located at the intersection of West Carolina Avenue and South Fifth Street opposite of the Hartsville City Hall to offer a weekly market providing fresh, locally grown farm produce, meats and cheeses, and baked goods approved by Main Street Hartsville's Juried Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City Manager is hereby authorized to waive the business license fees for participants at the Hartsville Farmers Market and the Centennial Market.
