RESOLUTION 12-16-03

APPROVAL TO AMEND COMMITTED CITY MATCH ALLOCATION FOR SOUTH HARTSVILLE REVITALIZATION COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hartsville applied for and was awarded \$500,000 through the Community Development Block Grant program for the purposes of demolishing the Lincoln Village Apartments and constructing a sidewalk on Marion Avenue from Sixth to Eighth Streets; and,

WHEREAS, as a condition of this award, the City committed grant match funds totaling approximately \$101,842, to include the clearance of nuisance lots and demolition of dilapidated houses totaling \$26,500 in value; and,

WHEREAS, the City has since been awarded more than \$400,000 for the demolition of derelict properties in the project area; and,

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the City Council African-American Cemetery Committee that these funds, estimated at Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500), be reallocated to offset the cost of vegetation abatement at the African-American Cemetery to avoid redundancy and allocate funding for an identified priority need.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the reallocation of the funds as described above and estimated at Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500) is hereby approved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all required documents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FINALLY RESOLVED, in meeting duly advertised and assembled the 13th day of December, 2016.
