

Monthly Departmental Report: Navigator 2019



Comprehensive Plan

January - May 2019: Statistical information is still being gathered and the Natural Resources & Transportation Elements are almost complete. The Housing Element is currently being compiled. Many of the Planning Commission members have provided a lot of information online for the remaining elements. There are a few elements where commission members will provide pictures and additional information over the next few months. No new information was added at the April planning commission meeting. Once all information is uploaded, it will then be compiled and completed for the remaining elements.

Ordinance Revision

January 2019: The Planning Commission met on January 28th to review the Alta Planning & Design Ordinance suggested changes. At this meeting, no action was taken so these ordinances will be further reviewed at February's Planning Commission meeting.

February 2019: The Planning Commission did not have a quorum for the February 25th meeting.

March 2019: The Planning Commission discussed and voted to allow staff to present a creative approach to the city's Sign Regulations Ordinance revision and present the updates at the May Planning Commission meeting.

April 2019: Due to several subdivisions of lots, the ordinance revision was not placed on the agenda. It will pick back up on the May agenda.

May 2019: Their Planning Commission did not have a meeting on May 27th, due to Memorial Day.
