#### **Applications**

#### The Blind Pig – 137 E. Carolina Ave. – awning, wall mounted & projecting sign

Lisa Weatherford and Dan Moses were present to participate in the discussion regarding an application to install a metal awning over the drive thru window and to remove the canvas awning over the patio and replace it with a metal awning. The application also included a 10 square foot wall mounted sign and a four (4) square foot projecting sign. The applicants withdrew the metal awnings. Rogers made a motion to approve the signs as submitted; Second: Tuten. Carried: All in favor.

## Justin Evans for Mayor – 122 W. Carolina Ave. – window sign

Jennifer Evans submitted an application to place a nine (9) square foot window sign on the front window. The sign was larger than what is allowed by ordinance. The size could not exceed 5.33 square feet. Tuten made a motion to approve the sign not to exceed 5.33 square feet; Second: Wingfield; Carried: All in favor.

## Brandon Price Insurance Agency – 112 W. Carolina Ave. – window & door sign

Dustin McClain was present to participate in the discussion regarding a proposal to place a 6.42 square foot sign on the lower portion of the windows and a 2.07 square foot sign on the window. Mr. McClain asked the board to consider approving painting the building an Antique White on all sides of the building. Wingfield expressed a concern about painting over the brick in the rear. Leeth made a motion to approve the paint on all sides of the building; Second: Tuten; Carried: All in favor. Wingfield made a motion to approve the window and door signs as submitted; Second: Rogers; Carried: All in favor.

## The Den Nutrition – 122 N. Fifth St. – projecting sign

Jonathon Mart was present to participate in the discussion regarding an application to place a 7.5 square foot sign on an existing metal arm. The business name would be etched in black. The fox would be etched in gray. Tuten made a motion to approve the sign as submitted; Second: Wingfield; Carried: All in favor.
