Sec. 78-434. Riding on sidewalks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle, skateboard, or like vehicle along or across any sidewalk within the B-1 business zone of the city; provided, however, . Lit shall be lawful to ride a nonmotorized bicycle on those sidewalks incorporated into the city bike path network. Within the remaining-all areas of the city, a person riding a bicycle, skateboard or like vehicle along or across any sidewalk shall yield the right-of-way to all pedestrians on the sidewalk and shall be subject to the following regulation:

No person shall ride a bicycle, skateboard, or like vehicle in a careless manner. Riding in a careless manner means the person rides a a bicycle, skateboard, or like vehicle in a manner that endangers or would be likely to endanger any person or property.

Sec. 74-4 recommended to be repealed in its entirety

Sec. 74-4. Use of coasters, roller skates, and skateboards restricted.

- (a) No person upon roller skates or riding in or by means of any coaster, toy
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to play games, roller skate, or use skateboards upon the roadway of any paved street in the city. Roller skates or skateboards shall not be used on sidewalks in the downtown business district.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to use roller skates or skateboards for skating on any of the sidewalks or streets within the corporate limits of the city, except such area as may be designated from time to time by the police department.
