APPROVAL FOR HARTSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT (HPD) TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA LAW ENFORCEMENT DIVISION (SLED) FOR CRIMINAL FACIAL RECOGNITION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) and the Hartsville Police Department (HPD) will provide a single- source, secure data and facial image warehouse environment in which the South Carolina law enforcement community could search to find criminal information, to include images, for the purpose of investigating and disrupting criminal activities. The Criminal Facial Recognition System is a unique system in which users have access to mugshots and South Carolina Probation, Parole, and Pardon Services (PPP) images to include demographic data and arrest information; and

WHEREAS, SLED is responsible for the purchase and maintenance of the hardware and software while HPD is responsible for the purchase and maintenance of devices necessary to access data contained within the Criminal Facial Recognition System.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the Memorandum of Understanding between the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) and the Hartsville Police Department in relation to the Criminal Facial Recognition System and any associated costs by the HPD is hereby approved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all required documents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, in meeting duly advertised and assembled the 8th day of March, 2022.
