### **August Projects/Events Update:**

New Main Street Manager, Matt Winburn, spent the month "learning the ropes" of the Main Street Program. Matt was able to network with his fellow Main Street peers at a training session in Laurens, and has brought back valuable information that he hopes to implement in Downtown Hartsville. Locally, Matt has spent time connecting with his departmental team, as well as city leadership, to learn the past programming of Main Street Hartsville, its history, and how we as a city can continue the forward momentum of this program. Most importantly, Matt has spent valuable face-to-face time with our downtown business owners and visitors, working to build bridges and strengthen relationships with our Downtown Community.

#### **Farmers Market and Downtown Block Parties:**

August was another busy month as Main Street Hartsville hosted the Hartsville Farmers Market with August's Farmers Market being a hit! We hosted over 40 vendors and farmers. The August Downtown Block Party was unfortunately canceled due to rain, and was rescheduled to September 30<sup>th</sup>. We are fortunate to have Terence Lonon and the Untouchables as the entertainment for this event, sponsored by Duke Energy.

After moving our Block Parties to Friday nights instead of Thursday night's we have seen an increase of attendees. We hope to do bigger and better this year to increase our overall attendance rate to over 40%. Block Parties will be held on East College Avenue from May – June and August – September on the third Friday from 6-9 p.m.

#### **Façade and Vibrancy Grants:**

On a Friday of each month, Main Street Hartsville will feature one business who has received a Façade or Vibrancy Grant. Sponsored by the Byerly Foundation and the Hartsville Parking, Beautification & Business Improvement Commission, these programs provide funding to be used by downtown businesses for replacement of exterior signage or awnings, repainting building exteriors, outdoor dining, and other projects. These grants fund 60/40 (Main Street Hartsville reimbursing 60%) of the project with a maximum reimbursement of \$1,000. In August, Main Street Hartsville rewarded Hair on Carolina a Façade Grant!

#### **Sponsorships:**

After sending out our sponsorship information for our 2022 events season in March we have already received positive responses back from companies looking to support the Main Street Hartsville mission.
