Mayor Pro Tem Andrews called the meeting to order at 10:02am and asked Councilmember Mack lead in the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENTATIONS

Mayor Pro Tem Andrews stated that he enjoyed Treats-on-the-Street, it was a wonderful event and he thanked staff for their work.

City Manager Moore explained that the Hartsville Police Department was out and about for the event and on Halloween.

MANAGER UPDATE

Hartsville Police Department is working diligently to protect and serve. Staff is working closely with Darlington County School District since last week when a gun was apprehended at school. There will be a continued increase in police presence.

An Artificial Intelligence (AI) camera system is available that will fully integrate with our current camera system. The current camera system needs to be better. Upgrade will add 45 AI cameras with license plate readers. This will bring us to a total of 270 cameras. There is interest from community partners to help with paying for the upgrade. City Manager Moore suggests a community partnership to help cover the cost of up to \$1 million with up to \$500,000 paid by the City using ARPA funds. Mayor Pro Tem Andrews suggested reaching out to partner with Darlington County School District and asked if the cameras continue to work during power outages. City Manager Moore will reach out to the school district. During power outages the cameras are also out.
