TO LEASE A PORTION OF PROPERTY AT 321 BELL AVENUE FROM DARLINGTON COUNTY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hartsville seeks to install cameras for the monitoring of illicit activity in order to increase the safety and well-being of citizens; and,

WHEREAS, land owner Darlington County Habitat for Humanity does willingly commit to lease a portion of its land to the City to allow for the installation of such monitoring equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the portion of land necessary to install and access this equipment for continued maintenance is hereby approved to be leased from Darlington County Habitat for Humanity from May 11, 2018 until that time when either party seeks to terminate the lease, at a one-time cost of \$1 (one dollar).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the negotiated lease agreement document.
