WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire a Caiman MRAP 6x6 Armored Personnel Carrier/Rescue Vehicle through the United States 1033 Program; and,

WHEREAS, this program allows for the transfer of excess equipment to civilian law enforcement agencies; and,
