Charlie Barrineau, MASC Field Services Manager – Stopped in to say hello and that he looks forward to working with Hartsville. Mayor Pennington stated that Mr. Barrineau was the former City Manager in Greenwood prior to joining the Municipal Association and he is replacing Bill Taylor as our Field Services Manager.

Proclamations - Mayor Pennington proclaimed:

Preserving Our Places in History Award for Hartsville's African American Cemetery – Councilmember Tre' Gammage expressed that it was an honor to receive this award. Adlena Graham started this project in the mid 90's and with the help of Johnny Andrews the city has adopted the cemetery as a project. Jannie Harriott made official presentation to the Mayor and Council.

Mayor Pennington recognized County Councilmember Albert Davis for attending the meeting. City

Council had a photo taken with him.

Girl Scouts attending the meeting were presented with the “first ever” City of Hartsville patches for their uniforms.

Storm Water Issues - Edith Byrd, 626 South Sixth Street – Ms. Byrd presented photos of the issues to Council and the Mayor asked that staff review the issues.
