## Special Tax Assessment for Rehabilitated Historic Properties Application for PRELIMINARY Certification

The City of Hartsville Code of Ordinances, Chapter , Sections authorizes a Special Tax Assessment for Rehabilitated Historic Properties that meet the criteria for eligibility. Upon Final Certification, eligible properties will receive an assessment equal to the assessed value at the time of preliminary certification. The special assessment period shall not exceed twenty (20) years in length. A separate application is required for Final Certification once the rehabilitation work has been completed. Completed applications, including all required attachments, should be mailed to: City of Hartsville Planning Department, Attn: Brenda Kelley, PO Box 2497, Hartsville, SC 29551.
