DISCUSSION OF FY 22-23 BUDGET:

City Manager explained total FY 22-23 budget of \$23,344,710 includes:

- 1. Slightly higher revenues
- 2. No tax increase proposed
- 3. 2% Cost of Living Adjustment for employees (COLA) included
- 4. Holding off on several capital items to wait and see if costs come down
- 5. Increase in commercial sanitation rates of 3% a year over 5 years.
- 6. Recommend revamping how we collect yard debris to keep yard waste out of the storm drains and increase productivity in the collection process.

Council would like to see the COLA increased to 3.5%.
