APPROVAL FOR HARTSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT (HPD) TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA LAW ENFORCEMENT DIVISION (SLED) FOR ACCESS TO THE AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER (ALPR) SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) and the Hartsville Police Department (HPD) will provide access to the Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) System back-office application for participation in system data sharing for the benefit of the citizens by better enforcing criminal laws through a corporative approach to law enforcement; and,

**WHEREAS,** the ALPR System is a system with the capability to query all sensor information stored within the application and can be accessed remotely by participating law enforcement agencies; and,

**WHEREAS,** SLED is responsible for the purchase and maintenance of the hardware and software while HPD is responsible for the purchase and maintenance of the sensor system and devices necessary to access data contained within the Automated License Plate Reader System.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the Memorandum of Understanding between the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) and the Hartsville Police Department (HPD) in relation to the Automated License Plate Reader System and any associated costs by the HPD is hereby approved.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all required documents.
