RESOLUTION 01-23--01

APPROVAL OF THE CREATION OF THE MAIN STREET HARTSVILLE (MSH) ADVISORY BOARD AND APPROVAL OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MAIN STREET HARTSVILLE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Main Street Hartsville (MSH) program handles matters relating to downtown revitalization and championing the program to the Hartsville community; and

WHEREAS, an Advisory Board needs to be established to make recommendations to City Council as needed and district boundaries need to be approved; and

WHEREAS, the five member Main street Hartsville Advisory Board "the Board" will follow the guidelines outlined in City Code Section Article IV. Boards, Commission and Committees Division 1. Generally Section 2-271 -2-281; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street Hartsville Advisory Board shall appoint, as needed, sub-committees to assist with focusing on elements as needed for the duration of the assigned project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed boundaries of the MSH district shall include and be comprised of: All those lots abutting both sides of named streets or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the City of Hartsville designated as a block beginning at the corner of North Sixth Street and West Home Avenue to the corner of East Home Avenue and North Fourth Street to the corner of South Fourth Street and East Laurens Avenue to the corner of West Laurens Avenue and South Sixth Street and to the corner of North Sixth Street and West Home Avenue (as shown on attached map).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the Main Street Hartville Advisory Board is hereby established with five members which shall be appointed by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the Main Street Hartsville district boundaries are hereby approved as shown on the attached map.

BE IT HEREBY FINALLY RESOLVED, in meeting duly advertised and assembled on the th day of January, 2023.
