

ORDINANCE 4456

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CITY OF HARTSVILLE CODE WITHIN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV DIVISION 4 SECTION 2-376 FOR PARKS COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hartsville, South Carolina (the “City”) is a municipal operation of the State of South Carolina, located in Darlington County, South Carolina, and as such possesses all general powers granted to municipal corporations; and

WHEREAS, City Council would like to amend and repeal sections of the current city code in Chapter 2 Administration, Article IV Boards, Commission and Committees, Division Parks Section 2-376 Parks Committee; and

WHEREAS, these sections have been reviewed and are being considered as shown below.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the Hartsville City Code is hereby amended and restated as follows:

Section 2-376 of the Hartsville City Code, as amended and restated, shall be codified and shall read, in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 2-376. Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee.

- (a) *Establishment.* There shall be a parks and recreation advisory committee composed of members appointed by the council.
- (b) *Powers and duties.* The parks and recreation advisory committee shall assist in recommending policies and procedures and shall formulate suggested plans for recreationally important activities and events within the city limits. Issues may also be forwarded from governmental entities to the committee for study and review. This body shall act solely in an advisory capacity to the city council.
- (c) *Purpose.* The purpose of this committee is to act as a study group to find ways to operate recreationally important facilities, activities, and events within the city limits of the City of Hartsville in an efficient and successful manner, enhancing the natural beauty and recreational opportunities of the community.
- (d) *Membership.* This committee shall consist of five members appointed by the city council to staggered terms of three years for a limit of two consecutive terms (Sec. 20274).. All five members shall be city residents.
- (e) *Officers.* Annually, at the first regular meeting following the appointment of new members, an election shall be held among the committee members for the positions of chair and vice-chair. The city shall provide a recording secretary for the committee.
- (f) *Meetings.* The committee shall meet on a bi-monthly basis at a time and place selected by the membership. A simple majority shall constitute a quorum.

No person shall ride a bicycle, skateboard, or like vehicle in a careless manner. Riding in a careless manner means the person rides a bicycle, skateboard, or like vehicle in a manner that endangers or would be likely to endanger any person or property.
