

RESOLUTION 04-17-04

COMMITMENT OF ADDITIONAL MATCH FUNDS FOR SOUTH HARTSVILLE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City was awarded \$500,000 in 2015 for the purposes of improvements in the South Hartsville neighborhood; and,

WHEREAS, upon application, the City committed matching funds with the acknowledged potential for incurring additional overage costs,

WHEREAS, the demolition and abatement element will cost significantly more than budgeted for and the Department of Commerce has approved an amendment in project scope to allow for the completion of said demolition, with City incurring the balance yet remaining.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City of Hartsville does hereby commit from the General Fund an additional \$50,000 in grant match funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hartsville that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all required documents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, in meeting duly advertised and assembled the 11th day of April, 2017.
